Huron Valley Glass Company will design and install 100,000 square feet of HVU Unitized Curtainwall/ Skylight and nearly 50,000 square feet of composite metal panel Rain Screen System. HVG was chosen due to its ability to work closely with St. Louis based Cannon

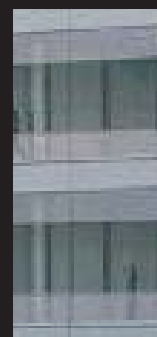
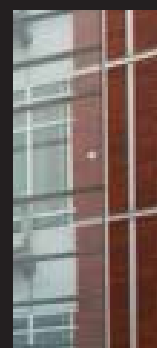
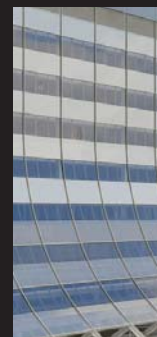
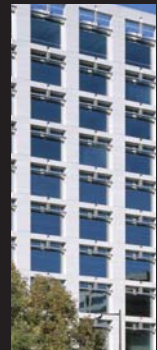
Architects and its strong relations with Gilbane, the Construction Manager.

The wall system will be factory assembled and glazed in the state of the art fabrication facility



operated by HVG in Massillon Ohio. HVG is currently installing the mock up specimen at the testing lab outside of St. Louis.

Fabrication of the UH Cancer Center units will start in February 2009 and field erection will commence in September 2009.

HVG will design and install nearly 180,000 square feet of HVU Unitized Curtain wall with multiple spandrel materials including simulated acid etched glass, pattern frit glass, composite metal panels and 3 cm limestone.

HVG will also install entrances, louvers and parking garage screens.
